WORLD WAR II D-DAY-LONDON, NORMANDY & PARIS TOUR ITINERARY

Day

Welcome to London, England

Upon arrival at London Heathrow Airport, you will have a private transfer to your hotel. Today is at your leisure to relax or explore on your own. This evening, join your Travel Director for a Welcome Reception at your hotel. (WR)

Day 2

London Sightseeing

Today, you'll visit the Royal Air Force Museum at Hendon and explore Winston Churchill's cabinet rooms. This evening you will dine in the iconic Harmsworth room. Later enjoy a ride on the London Eye for magnificent views of the city. (B, D)

Day 3

London to Portsmouth

Today, travel to Portsmouth and visit the Southwick House to see its famous Map Wall and learn about the history of this allied headquarters. Continue onto the D-Day Museum and see the personal accounts of people who were there and with stunning audio-visual presentations. (B)

Hotel: Portsmouth Marriott or similar - 1 night

Day 4

Caen & Normandy

Travel in the footsteps of the soldiers as you cross the English Channel from Portsmouth into Caen, France and head to your hotel. (B)

Hotel: Novotel Caen Cote de Nacre or similar - 2 nights

Day 5

Sainte-Mère-Église

Visit the Airborne Museum in Sainte- MèreÉglise, one of the first towns liberated after D-Day. See the town church spire that American paratrooper John Steele got caught on before the Germans took him prisoner. Then explore the Dead Man's Corner Museum and experience the thrill of the Stoy Hora C-47 simulation. This evening enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 6

Normandy Beaches, D-Day Landings - Paris

There are poignant reminders of World War II as you travel past Juno and Gold beaches, which both played a part in the 1944 Normandy landings. Visit the D-Day Museum and see the remnants of the artificial port in the bay of Arromanches. Then with a Local Expert, spend a few reflective moments at the American Military Cemetery of Saint-Laurent near Omaha Beach before following the route of the Rangers and visiting the bunkers and the Rangers

Memorial at Pointe du Hoc. Continue onto your hotel in Paris. Enjoy dinner tonight to relive the memories of this week. (B, D)

Hotel: Courtyard by Marriott Paris Porte De Versailles or similar - 2 nights

Day 7

The City of Light

Join your Travel Director this morning for a tour of this mesmerizing city. View the grand Champs-Élysées, Eiffel Tower, Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe, built for Napoleon in the 19th century. The rest of the day is free for you to explore on you own, before your Farewell Dinner cruise on the Seine. (B, D)
