Day 1

Rome (Civitavecchia Port) Embarkation - Odyssey of the Seas

Day 2

Cruising

Day 3

Barcelona, Spain

Scale the hilltop to dramatic La Alcazaba fortress, dating back to the 11th century that overlooks this ancient seaside city. Sun yourself on the idyllic beaches of Caleta and Malagueta and see the eccentric works of Pablo Picasso, the city's most famous native son, at the Picasso Museum.

Day 7
